Competitors Regulations

1. The Championship will be known as "The ROADRUNNER PHOENIX AWARDS ANEMMC Stage Rally Championship 2019"
2. Events to be included in the championship have been selected from events nominated by member clubs and approved at an Association meeting. These events have been observed and approved for inclusion in the Championship.
3. All fully paid up members or member clubs who have registered as contenders as a Driver or Co-driver and who have paid the registration fee shall be eligible to compete. Registration must have been made and accepted before any event for which points can be scored.
4. The Championship will be divided into 5 classes as follows:
5.
 - Class 1 ~ Up to 1400cc
 - Class 2 ~ 1401cc to 1600cc
 - Class 3 ~ 1601cc to 2000cc
 - Class 4 ~ over 2000cc
 - Class 5 ~ all 4 wheel drive cars

Vehicles with Rotary or forced induction will have their engine capacity increased by 70% to determine their class eligibility in accordance with Motorsport UK regulations.

Permitted Fuels:

Competitors are only permitted to use fuel that conforms to the definitions of pump fuel in the 2019 Motorsport UK Yearbook. Fuel additives are not permitted unless specified in the Motorsport UK definition of Pump Fuel.

5. Points will be awarded in the Championship with reference to class positions in the official results and relative to his/her performance against other registered contenders. Points can only be awarded to contenders on NAT B Stage Rallies where an event may be a round of a National series.

Points will be awarded as follows:

1 st in class	30 points
2 nd in class	29 points
3 rd in class	28 points
4 th in class	27 points
5 th in class	26 points etc.

1 point will be added to your class score for every competitor beaten in your class who finish the event. Competitors who have retired will not count.

A retirement on an event will be awarded 6 points.

The Championship will be 12 events with Best 7 Scores to Count.

In the event of any events not running the following will apply

- 12 or 10 rounds 7 to score
- 9 or 8 rounds 6 to score
- 7 or 6 rounds 5 to score
- 5 rounds 5 to score
- less than 5 all to count

Awards for the overall championship will be as follows:

- 1st-2nd-3rd Overall Driver-Co-Driver
 - 1st-2nd 3rd in each Class Driver-Co-Driver (depending on no. of entries)
 - Highest placed Rear wheel drive car Driver Award
 - Highest placed Front wheel drive car Driver Award
 - Highest Placed Lady Driver Award
 - Highest Placed Lady Co-Driver Award
 - Under 25 Driver and Co-Driver (**must make known at time of registration**)
- To receive an award a competitor must have scored a finish.**

No competitor may win more than one award other than a Ladies award, Under 25. In the event of a tie, the competitor scoring the highest number of first places taken the higher placing; then scoring the highest number of second

places and so on until the tie is resolved. In the event of a double tie we will take highest score on the first event competed on.

6. It is the competitor's responsibility to obtain event regulations.
7. Acceptance of all entries will be at each organiser's discretion and ANEMMC cannot be held responsible for any refusal of entries.
8. Entrants must indicate their registration for the ANEMMC championship on their event entry forms.
9. Once a competitor has paid their registration fee and returned the registration form points shall automatically be collated from events results without further signing-on at each event. Registration cards may be required at signing-on at the discretion of each individual event organisers.
10. It is not necessary for Drivers and Co-drivers to be in the same crew for all events, during the year, as results will be kept for each category.
11. Registered contenders will be supplied with two Championship decals, which must be displayed on the competing car at all events.
